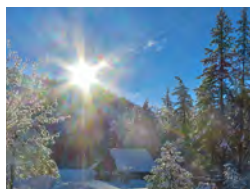

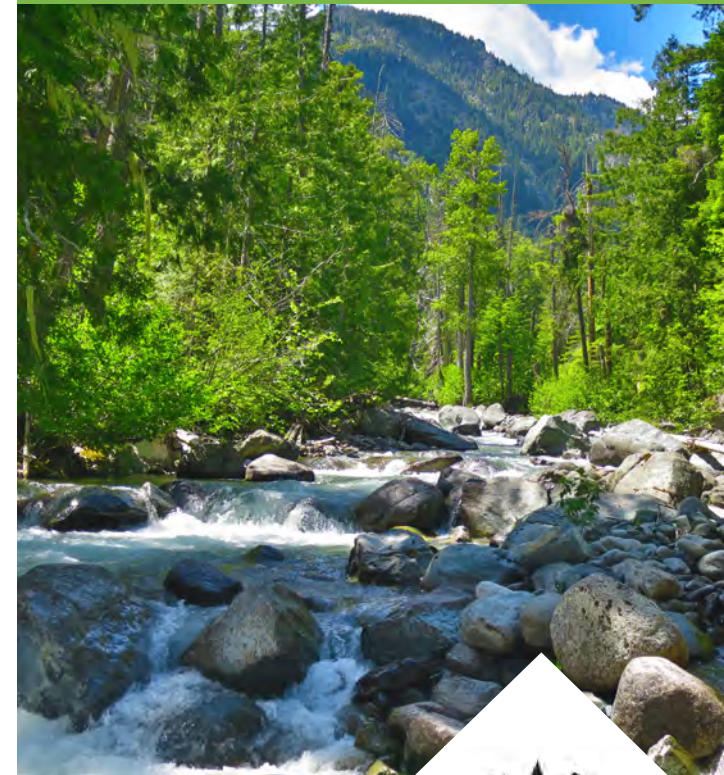

Ingalls Creek Enrichment Center gathers people who seek to connect their faith, life, and work in the richness of community, sending them into our changing society with a renewed sense of Christian calling.

### Investing Our Values

### Historical Perspective

The Ingalls Creek Enrichment Center grew from a "gleam in the eye" back in 1980 into a well-loved 15 acre parcel along the banks of Ingalls Creek. The center now features a fully functional lodge, gazebo, zip line, amphitheater, and beautiful lawns.

Thousands of people, including groups of all ages, have already been touched by God at this site. Feedback includes encouraging phrases such as, "we love it here," "what an amazing setting in the heart of God's creation," and "love and grace abound here."

The center was launched in 1989 with founding Board members Alan and Anna Waltar, Steve and Sandra Critchlow, Lane and Gwen Bray, and Roger and Carol Johnson.

The Legacy Endowment Fund, established in 2015, is managed by the Community Foundation of North Central Washington--an organization founded to help non-profit organizations in our region. CFNCW has a well-established record, now managing over 50 million dollars in assets for charitable organizations.
